Key Eligibility Requirements for SLES



Requirements for SLES and Finding and Keeping a Job:

- * Has a current NDIS plan with SLES or Finding and Keeping a Job funding.
- * Is motivated to work and/or to develop skills to become work ready.
- * Is willing to accept support and assistance from Essential Personnel.
- * Is supported by their family (or significant other), where involved, to secure and maintain employment.
- * Is prepared to take part in work experience
