The Multicultural Enterprise Development project is a joint initiative by the Metropolitan Migrant Resource Centre and Multicultural Futures offering people from migrant and refugee backgrounds an opportunity to gain new skills and industry experience creating a collective social enterprise.

The new *World Music Café* enterprise initiative will be developed from August 2019 to June 2020 to deliver a series of independent cultural events across Perth.

Participation in the project is voluntary and requires attending regular weekly sessions over a three month term and assisting with the coordination of the *World Music Café* events.

The Multicultural Enterprise Development project is supported by the Department of Social Services and participants who receive income support may gain credits towards their employment agency obligations.

Learn new skills and work collectively

The *World Music Café* enterprise is a collective capacity building experience as participants 'learn-by-doing' and gain knowledge in the following areas guided by experienced industry mentors.

- Social enterprise principles, collective goal setting
- Business planning, structures, entrepreneurial mindset
- Financial planning and budgeting
- Funding, grants, sponsorships, donations, patrons, online funding
- Contracts, legal compliance
- Marketing, audience development
- Event management, production management, ticketing systems
- OHS compliance, insurance, risk management
- Food safety, catering fundamentals
- Artist management, artist development

Eligibility

To participate in the *World Music Café* enterprise, participants should:

1. Be from a refugee or migrant background
2. Aged between 16-64
3. Have a right to work in Australia
4. Receive income support or be at risk of exclusion from economic participation
