1. To comply with the Adult Ethos of the Campus along with the Code of Expectations and Behaviour for Students.
2. Provide consent during my enrolment for the campus to communicate with any of my contacts listed on my enrolment form in regards to attendance, engagement, behaviour or learning concerns.
3. Attendance in class is compulsory and in order to be successfully resulted, I must maintain an attendance ratio of **greater than 80%**. Students unable to make that commitment are required to proactively communicate with both their teachers and Student Services. All absences must be reasonably explained via letter, phone, text, email or in person.
4. Students have freedom of movement on and off the campus during non-class contact time, but are held accountable to the courses they are enrolled into. This means it is a student's responsibility to be on time, prepared and ready for learning during their timetabled class. Students should not be in other classrooms, library or other school facilities during their scheduled classes.
5. Post-Compulsory students (18+) not engaging in their learning by falling more than three assignments behind, or with an attendance rating of 50% or lower without explanation will have their enrolment terminated. An improvement letter will be issued warning of this action.
6. Pay the associated course, contribution and certificate fees as enrolled. In the case of Certificates, students will not be enrolled until 50% of the cost has been received. If I change course or withdraw from any course, fees will only be refunded as per the guidelines in the student Information and Course Handbook.
7. That the Campus has a dedicated Student Services Team who can support me when I am experiencing difficulty, assist with resolutions and negotiate outcomes to continue my education success.
