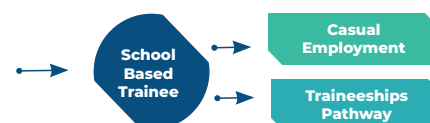
You may also gain experience working as a receptionist and cafe assistant based on seasonal demands.

OFF – THE – JOB TRAINING

In order for you to satisfy all elements of the traineeship, you will partake in training programs that will be fully funded.

- **Certificate III Sport and Recreation: SIS30115**
 - A Certificate III is an eligible entry point for some courses at some universities.
 - Clusters of units completed online
 - Scheduled on-site training and assessment days
- **Pool Lifeguard Course: 3 day course + shadow shifts**
- **Learn to Swim Course: 1 day course + 20 hours of shadow teaching**
